

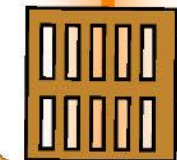
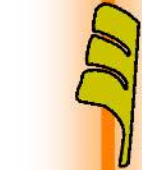
Year 3/4 Homework: Choose from the activities below.

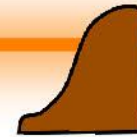
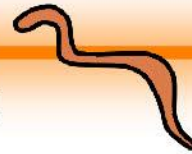
You must choose at **LEAST one activity** but you may choose to do more.

What would his answers be? OR Imagine that you are an archaeologist that has just discovered a pharaoh's tomb. Write a letter saying how you feel about your discovery.</p>	<p>Research a pharaoh and present your findings in an interesting way.</p>
<p>Create a collage of a Nile crocodile or desert animal such as a camel.</p>	<p>Make a flatbread or sweetbread containing dates, honey or figs. Please take photos of your cooking to share or choose another Egyptian style dish.</p>	<p>Create an advertisement for a job in Ancient Egypt, such as a carpenter, doctor, jewellery maker, farmer or assistant to the pharaoh.</p>
