Tasks

Weekly spelling

20 spellings

(Please learn and test at the end of the week)

There are ten Year 5 spellings and ten Year 6 spellings. Year 6s must learn them all. Year 5s must learn and Year 5 spellings and can choose to also learn the Year 6 spellings if they wish.

Spellings can be accessed via the purplemash 'Spring 2021 Homework folder' in the correct week. Children have used this same system in the Autumn term and so should be familiar with where to find their spellings.
