




Advancing geography and geographical learning

This term refers to the **islands** of Great Britain and Ireland – including the Republic of Ireland – and the 5000 or so smaller islands scattered around our coasts, such as the **Channel Isles and Isle of Man.**



(Remember this only refers to geography, not nationality, and while the Republic of Ireland is part of the British Isles, it is a separate country and the people are not British).

Advancing geography and geographical learning

This is the official collective name of **England**, **Scotland and Wales and their associated islands**.

It does not include Northern Ireland and therefore should not be used interchangeably with 'UK.'


