layering

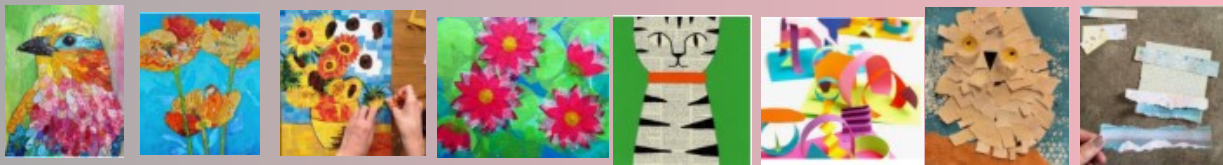
Paper techniques

cut flat - more complex shapes

cut and curl

cut and fold

cut and twist



tear - simple shapes, soft edges

layering

scrunch and flatten - texture



Papers to use

news paper, white paper, coloured paper, thick paper, tissue paper,
sugar paper, thin card, thick card, wrapping paper

Other materials

foil, fabric, natural materials - sticks, leaves, cotton wool, wool,
string, ribbon,
