





Phonics

Well done for practising your segmenting and blending skills over half term. It has really supported our phonics learning this week. We have even attempted writing CVC words this week! Our new phonemes this week are: m, d, g and o. Plus the tricky word 'go'.



Home challenge: Can you have a go at reading then writing these CVC words:

Maths

This weeks number is number 3. We continued to explore how this number can be represented. We used our part-part whole models to help us find all the ways of making 3. This supported us with paying for our snack as we realised that a 3p coin doesn't exist!
