




Rabbits weekly newsletter

This week we have been reading the story 'Lubna and Pebble'. Lubna is a refugee who, along with her father, are looking for a new home away from harm. We thought about people who could help us if we were hurt, upset, feeling unwell or had a problem. We drew around our hands and added the names of these people to our fingers and thumb.



Phonics

We recapped Phase 1 phonics in preparation for the beginning of phase 2 next week. This included a listening walk to pick out environmental sounds, a musical instrument quiz, some body percussion, rhythm and rhyme, and alliteration.

Home challenge: Go on a listening walk at home, either in your local area or around your house. Take photos or draw pictures to show what sounds you heard. You could talk to your grown up about which sounds were the same or different from the ones we heard at school. Upload these to Tapestry.

Library

We visited our school library this week. Before going we discussed some good rules for being in the library. The children suggested being quiet, looking after the books and remembering to return the book after borrowing them.

Home challenge: Can you share a photo of you with your favourite book on Tapestry, let us know why it is your favourite book.
