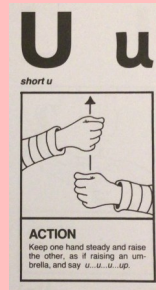
On Thursday we took part in a 2-minutes silence to remember all the soldiers who fought in the war and have been learning a song in assembly.

Maths

This weeks number is number 4. We continued to explore how this number can be represented including shapes that have 4 sides and 4 corners. We sorted concrete objects and pictorial representations into groups of '4' and 'not 4'. We continued to use our part-part whole models to help us find all the ways of making 4.
