Maths

Our number of the week is number 5. The children have worked very hard to recognise the digit, count out loud of 5, carefully count 5 objects and to find all the pairs of numbers that make 5.

Home challenge:

Place 5 objects in front of your child. Ask them to put them in a line and carefully touch and count them. Make sure they are saying each number at the same time as touching an object. Keep practising this if needed. If your child can do this confidently and accurately, try the attached sheet for some additional ideas.
