

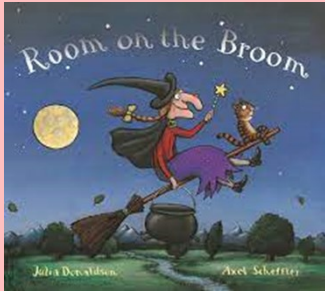

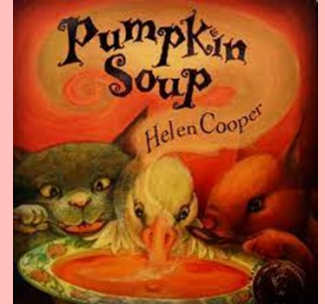


Please can you check that your child hasn't brought home a pink Next hoodie by mistake, it has been missing since our non-uniform day. If found please return it to school. Thank you

We have been exploring Autumn and Halloween this week. Our texts 'Pumpkin Soup' and 'Room on the Broom' have led to some fantastic activities.



We have been re-telling the story using props and making wands to practise our cutting and joining skills. We've even had a go at some observational drawings of different squashes, using a range of media.



Phonics

We have continued to learn some more phase 2 phonemes this week, they are: i and n. We also practised reading some words by segmenting and blending using our chopping hands. Our tricky word this week is 'no'.

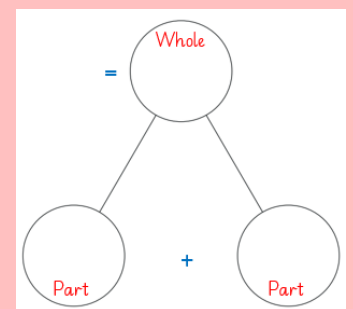
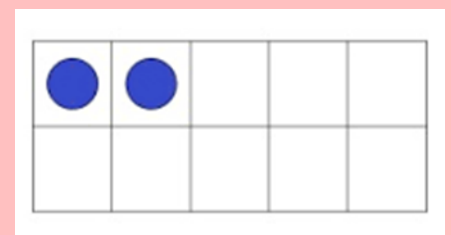
Home challenge: See attached 'phonics home challenge' to practise segmenting and blending skills.



Maths

We moved onto the number 2 this week. As well as learning about how the number can be represented we looked at some maths structures to support our understanding of how the number can be made up. On the right is a tens frame and a part-part whole model (for addition). We explored different ways of making 2 and how this can be recorded as a number sentence too ($1+1=2$).

Home challenge: Practise using a part-part whole model and physical objects such as counters, pasta or beads. How many ways can you make 2?
