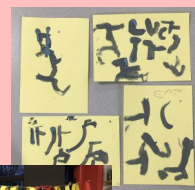


A huge congratulations to Mrs Prickett whose baby arrived on 1st February!! The children were so excited to hear this wonderful news.

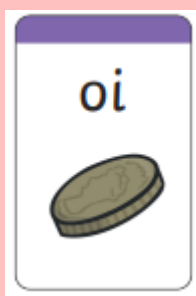


On Friday we took part in the NSPCC number day involving lots of fun maths activities and challenges.

We have continued to learn more digraphs (two letters together to make one sound) and trigraphs this week (three letters together to make one sound). Our new phonemes are: oi, air and ear

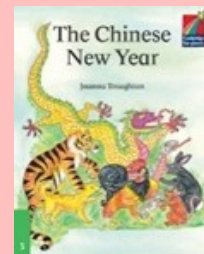
Our tricky word is: they

Maths

In Maths this week we used the story of the Chinese New Year to support us with learning about ordinal numbers— 1st, 2nd, 3rd etc. We had a go at some races of our own to help us with our understanding.
