

Happy New Year! We are so proud of how the children have settled back in to the new term and the wonderful learning they have done already!

We've started off this term with a space theme. Our focus text has been 'Whatever Next' by Jill Murphy. The children have been using props to re-tell the story. We have looked at specific vocabulary from the book; passengers, draining board, helmet, journey, chimney, state and smart. We discussed their meanings and have been trying to use them during role play and re-telling of the story. This week some of us have made story maps to support us with remembering the story, we will be continuing this next week.

Phonics

This week and last week we have been learning all about digraphs., which are when two letters work together to make one sound. We have learnt about the digraphs qu, ch, sh, th, ng & ai. Our tricky words are: he, she, we and me.

Maths

Last week we learnt all about the number 10, including recognising the digits, counting objects and finding ways of making 10. This week we opened a shop in our role play area! We looked at the coins from 1p-10p and began to explore different ways of making these amounts.
