We've continued working on story maps for our focus text 'Whatever Next' this week. We hope you have enjoyed watching the recordings of us on Tapestry.

This week we also looked at a couple of astronauts— Tim Peake and Mae Jemison. We thought about why they were important figures in history; Tim Peake being the first British person in space; Mae Jemison being the first black lady in space.

As part of our work on diversity, in PSHE we looked at different activities/ experiences families enjoy doing together. We noticed that some of us liked doing the same things and others didn't.



## Phonics

We have continued to learn more digraphs this week (two letters together to make one sound), as well as a trigraph (three letters together to make one sound): ee., or, igh and oa.

Our tricky words are: be and was.



**Home challenge:** Complete the 'real or nonsense' sheet/s. Choose 2 different colouring pencils, then sound out the words and decide whether they are a real word or a nonsense word and colour them in accordingly.

## Maths

This week we have continued our learning on coins. We looked at how to make up to 10p using 1p coins and how to make 2p - 6p using different coins. The children have found this a little tricky so we have revisited it in our role play shop throughout the week.

**Home challenge:** Choose a few toys or objects from home to make your own pretend shop. Price the items from 1p-6p. Use 1p coins or a mixture of coins to buy them.
