
Ask the children if they can remember one way of saying hello.

Maths

This week we have been exploring length using the vocabulary *longer* and *shorter*. We discussed how length is measured horizontally, as opposed to vertically for height. The children were challenged to draw around their foot and find something in the classroom that was longer or shorter than their foot.

Home challenge: Can you find some things in your home that are longer or shorter than your foot? Have a go at ordering the snakes (sheet attached).
