

### **English – Text based on A Roman Mystery**

Children will be developing their skills in writing by creating their own Roman Mystery text. They will also focus on editing and punctuation skills across all their writing.

### **PE**

Children will be developing the necessary skills to play cricket, archery and tennis. Children will also use their dancing skills for the school production.

### **Art**

In art the children will be working on creating their own mosaic, having looked at Roman mosaics found in Britain.

### **Maths**

We will be following the Maths curriculum where we will be covering number, shape, measures, data handling, fractions, decimals and percentages. There will also be a focus on problem solving and investigative work. It is vitally important that children can swiftly recall number facts related to the multiplication tables.

Year 6's will also be learning exam technique to assist with their SATs.

### **Topic Plan**

#### **'Roman Conquest'**

Year 5 and 6  
Summer 2022

### **R.E. Philosophy and humanism**

Exploring what philosophy is and also looking at key humanistic ideas and beliefs

### **Music**

### **Science – Properties and changes of materials**

Children will be comparing and classifying materials based on their properties, developing an understanding how to separate mixtures and solutions. They will also learn about reversible and irreversible changes.

Children will be encouraged to develop their knowledge of the topic by asking questions and working independently to find out the relevant information to answer these.
