

The Vaccinators on Tour have got a busy summer ahead offering local communities COVID-19 vaccination clinics. These clinics will be offering first, second, third primary and booster doses of the life-saving COVID-19 vaccine to get everyone prepped for their summertime plans.

- Cambourne Hub, Tuesday 30 August, 12pm – 6pm (open to anyone aged 5+)
- Ely Cathedral, Saturday 3 September, 9.30am- 4.30pm (open to anyone aged 5+)
