(starfish, pebbles etc)</p> <p>Cut and stick a picture</p>	<p><u>How to Build a Sandcastle</u></p> <p>Write instructions to tell someone how to build a sandcastle. Can you include drawings or photos?</p>	<p><u>Mermaids</u></p> <p>Mermaids are mythical creatures. Can you create your own mermaid?
