Mouth open, then push the cs/x sound through as you close your mouth cs cs $cs(x \times x)$

Formation phrase

From the top, across the box to the bottom. From the top again across the box to the bottom.



Pronunciation phrase-w

Pucker your lips and keep them small as you say w w w

Formation phrase

Down and up and down and up the

Pronunciation phrase-y



Smile, tongue to the top of your mouth, say y without opening your mouth yyy

Formation phrase

Down, around the yo-yo and curl round the string.
