<u>Y5/6 Mayan Optional Homework (Spring term)</u>

The aim of these topic tasks are to provide the children with more opportunities to develop the 5Rs - readiness, responsibility, reflectiveness, resourcefulness and resilience; to promote independent learning and to inspire a love of learning.
