We will be sending school reading books home but please remember to return these promptly once read as we have a limited amount to share across the phase.

Your child will bring home a Termly Homework Book. This will be used for their homework linked to the termly units of work across the year. It will currently have a set of *The Big City* based activities to choose from. Once a piece of work has been completed you can either take a photograph and upload to Purple Mash or send the work into school with your child to share with the class on a Friday. Work uploaded to Purple Mash can be accessed by your child's class teacher and then be shared with the class. Certificates and smiley faces will be awarded at the end of the term for their hard work.
