## Reception Phonics Home Learning

Phase 2 - Autumn | Week 2

Focus - Phonemes i / n / m / d



Phonemes we focused on this week:



**Pronunciation phrase- i**

Pull your lips back and make the i sound at the back of your mouth i i i

**Formation phrase**

Down the iguana and dot the leaf.



**Pronunciation phrase- n**

Open your lips a bit, put your tongue behind your teeth and make the nnnnn sound nnnnn

**Formation phrase**

Down, up and over the net.



**Pronunciation phrase- m**

Put your lips together and make the mmmmm sound mmmmm

**Formation phrase**

Down, up and over the mouse's ears.



**Pronunciation phrase- d**

Put your tongue to the top and front of your mouth and make a quick d sound d d d

**Formation phrase**

Round the duck's body, up to its head and down to its feet.

Pronunciation phrase is used to support saying the phoneme (sound)

Formation phrase is used to support writing the grapheme (letter shape)

We practised orally blending these words. *Can you practise saying each phoneme then listening out for the word?*

p - i - t

m - a - t

d - i - p

d - a - d

s - a - d

n - a - p

m - a - p

m - a - n

p - a - n
