Phonics

This week we have continued to focus on those digraphs we have covered in the last few weeks. These can often prove to be trickier to apply in reading and writing as children need to remember that the grapheme contains two letters. If you have the grapheme flashcards at home, continue to use them to consolidate this learning— ch, sh, th, ng and nk.

We have practised reading words containing digraphs via the Phonicsplay games, aiming to score 10 every time!
