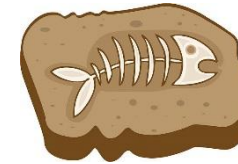


# Earth Matters!

Year 3/4 Topic Homework - Spring Term 2026



Choose one piece of work that you are particularly interested in and work on it in detail so that you produce one fabulous project style piece of work, rather than work on lots of the activities.

We ask that all homework is emailed or given to the class teacher **by Friday 13<sup>th</sup> March** so that we have time for all children to share their work with their class.

<p><b>Be an explorer:</b> Explore the world using Google Earth or an atlas. Map out the location of the continents and find famous physical features in each continent.</p>	<p><b>Be creative:</b> Write a short story about being involved in an earthquake or volcano. Describe the setting, characters and problems you come across.</p>	<p><b>Be constructive:</b> Make a 3D model of a human or physical feature of our Earth using junk materials from home. Find out about the feature.</p>	<p><b>Be accurate:</b> Create a fact file about famous volcanoes and/or earthquakes. Make sure that you include number facts.</p>
<p><b>Be a story writer, journalist or news reporter:</b> Write a story, newspaper report or record a news article about finding an amazing fossil. Where was it found? Why is it newsworthy?</p>	<p><b>Be a researcher:</b> Use the computer or visit a library to gather and present information about famous rock formations, volcanoes or earthquakes around the world.</p>	<p><b>Be artistic:</b> Make a collage, sketch or a painting of a famous rock formation or physical feature of our world. Research the feature.</p>	<p><b>Be statistical:</b> Look at the climate around the world. How is it different in different locations. Present your information in a chart, table or graph.</p>
<p><b>Be a poet:</b> Write a poem, in a style of your choice, about any aspect of our topic, 'Earth Matters.'</p>	<p><b>Be resourceful:</b> Make your own pretend fossils or prints of fossils of bugs, insects or plants by using different materials such as play dough and plasticine. Record information about your fossil.</p>	<p><b>Be a foody:</b> Find a recipe and follow it carefully, cooking some food that could be related to our topic. (Eg. Earth Day food, rock cakes, planet Earth cake) Remember to take photos and tell us how tasty it was!</p>	<p><b>Be imaginative:</b> Make an insect hotel for your garden to help protect bugs and insects. Take photos and be prepared to tell us how you made it.</p>
