EU Kids Online Report June 2012

Towards a better internet for children

43% Of 9-16 year olds SNS users keep their profile private

28% have it partially private

26% have it public

.....are also more likely to display their phone number or address on their SNS profile

15% Sent personal information to someone they have never met face-to-face.

14% Of 9-16 year olds have seen sexual images on websites

32% who hadsaid they were upset by them

33% Go online via a mobile phone or handheld device

21% Of 11-16 year olds have seen potentially harmful user-generated content eg hate, pro-anorexia, self-harm sites

49% Of children go online in their bedroom.

Use child friendly search engines.....put quick links on the desktop

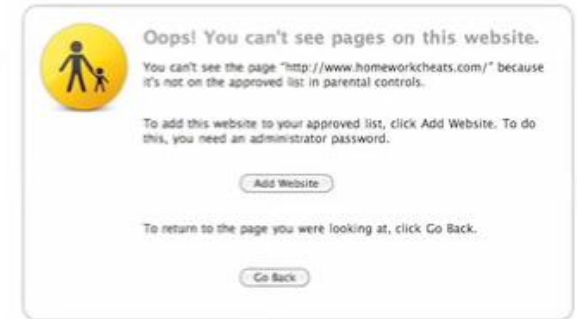
