Reading Activities for FICTION

LO: Become an illustrator

Draw a picture of your favourite part of the story. Write 2 sentences to explain it.

LO: Design a quiz

Write at least 3 questions about your reading book. Make sure you know the answers.

LO: Find new vocabulary

Find 4 new words in your book. Find out what they mean by using a dictionary.

LO: Invent a new character

Describe a new character that could go into your story.

LO: Design a Front Cover

Design a new cover for the book. Include a picture, title, author and illustrator.

LO: Describe my favourite part

Write down what your favourite part of the story was and explain why you liked it.

LO: Ask a character questions

Write a list of questions you would like to ask a character in your story.

LO: Find adjectives

Open your book to any page. Write down at least 5 adjectives (describing words). Now put them in your own sentences.

LO: Finding suffixes

Be a word hunter and find 10 words ending with a suffix. Eg helpful, running, jumped

LO: Design a poster

Make a missing poster for a character in your story. What do they look like? What did they do? Include a reward.

LO: Finding plurals

Be a word hunter and find words in your story that are plurals (more than one). Draw a table in your book.
