Reading Activities for FICTION

LO: Write a new blurb

Write a new blurb for your book. Make sure you make the book sound exciting!

LO: Design a Poster

Make a poster to advertise your guided reading book. Use persuasive language to encourage people to read it.

Example: The greatest adventure story you will ever read. This is the book of the year!

LO: Describe the setting

Describe where and when the story took place. Explain why you would or wouldn't like to go there.

LO: Become an illustrator

Draw a picture of your favourite part of the story. Write 2 sentences to explain it.

LO: Change the ending

Write a different way your story could end.

LO: Invent a new character

Describe a new character that could go into your story.

LO: Create a story map

LO: Find keywords

Write down ten keywords that are important to your reading book. They may include characters, setting, what happens.

LO: Write a letter

Write a letter to one of the characters in your reading book. Include at least one question you want to ask them.

LO: Design a Front Cover

Design a new cover for the book. Include a picture, title, author and illustrator.

LO: Write an Acrostic Poem

Choose a character in your book and write an acrostic poem about them.

LO: Design a quiz

Write at least 5 questions about your reading book. Make sure you know the answers.

LO: Ask a character questions

Write a list of questions you would like to ask a character from your book.

LO: Write a book review
