2. In the hall, there are 1355 children. Another 1123 children enter the hall. How many children are in the hall overall?
3. 2264 children are in the swimming pool. An extra 1129 children enter the swimming pool. How many children are in the swimming pool?
4. 3641 apples have fallen to the ground. 2273 more apples fall to the ground from the apple tree. How many apples are on the ground now?
5. In the library, there are 6445 books. At lunch time, the children return 1833 books. How many books are in the library after lunch?
6. Scruffy the dog ate 3367 bones and then an extra 2924 bones. How many bones did Scruffy the dog eat?
7. There are 6281 apples and 3148 pears in the box. How many fruits are there in total?
8. There are 7336 ducks and 1865 swans on a lake. How many birds altogether?
