2. There are 289 children in a school. 154 are in Key Stage 2. How many children are not in KS2?
3. There are 395 pencils in the school store cupboard. 168 are given out to some teachers. How many are left in the store cupboard?
4. A flower market has 432 tulips. A florist buys 155 tulips. How many are left?
5. A farmer has 584 cows. He takes 246 to a new field. How many are left behind?
6. A teacher counts all the exercise books that her class has used during the year and finds there are 237 in total. 96 are Maths books. How many other books are there?
