4) Sam's water bottle contains 658ml of water. Sam drinks 389ml water during golden mile. How much water is left in his bottle?

5) A train ticket to Cambridge costs £5.86 and a ticket to London costs £9.78. How much more does it cost to travel to London?

6) Sasha walks 5.68m as part of a sponsored walk. Her friend James walked 7.87m. How far did they walk in total?

7) Wilma needs 565g of flour to make a birthday cake. The bag contains 876g. How much flour will she have left over?

8) A child's ticket to the cinema costs £1.25 and an adult ticket costs £3.35.

How does it cost for 2 children and 1 adult to go to the cinema?
